Selection

Membership in this society is by nomination and review committee selection only. The selection committee includes state and county 4-H staff members, Michigan 4-H Foundation trustees and current Emerald Clover Society members.

Each nominee is selected based on evidence of three or more years of Michigan 4-H youth membership, professional and business achievement, leadership in community service and philanthropy, contributions to or impact on American society and significant leadership and achievement as a 4-H member. Nominees must be living.
